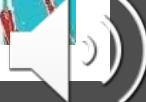


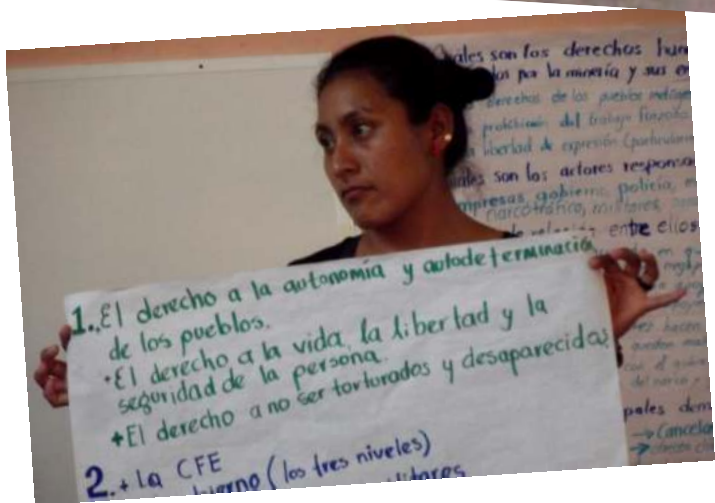
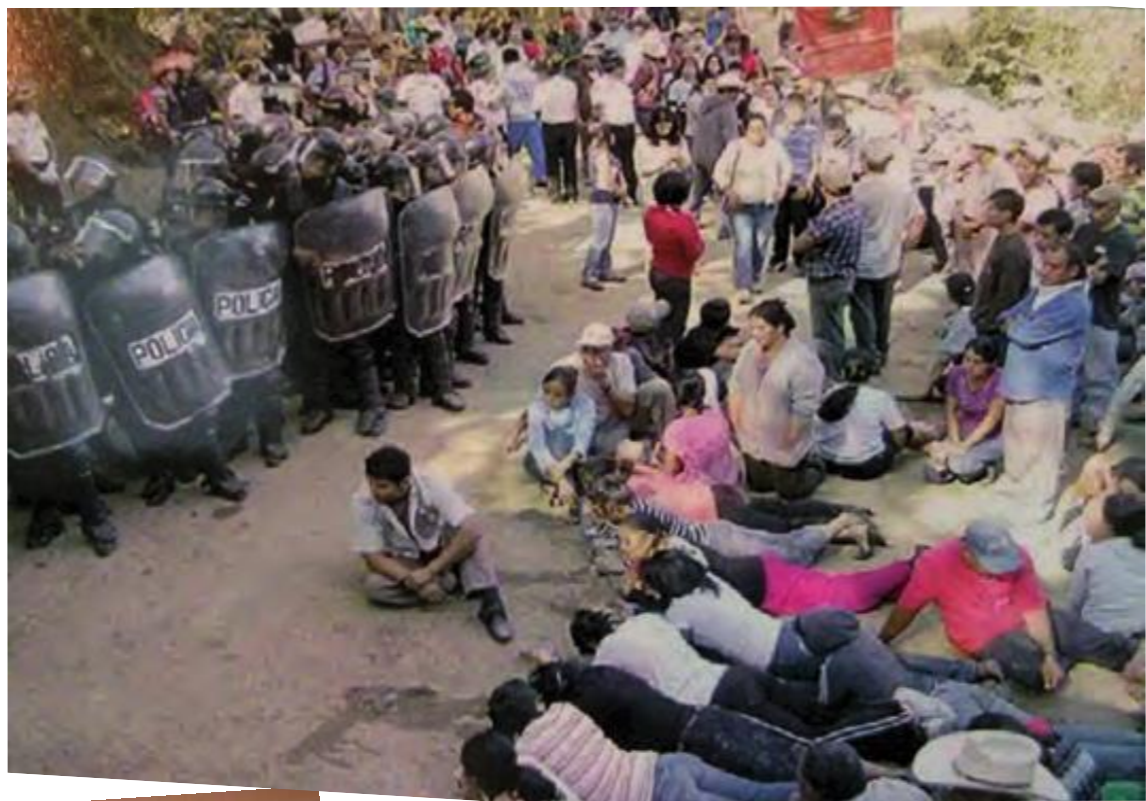

Inter-ethnic and fratricidal wars have plagued the territory of Uvira in the Democratic Republic of Congo in the heart of the African Great Lakes region. Pax Christi Uvira is helping to build peace through school programs that promote human rights, teach democratic culture and train young people in active nonviolence. They are reaching across ethnic boundaries and practicing inter-ethnic reconciliation as the first step toward replacing a culture of violence with a culture of peace. This work extends to refugee camps where Burundian refugees and local Congolese children attend classes and, as pictured here, jump rope together. Through active nonviolence, Pax Christi Uvira and the 120 member organisations of Pax Christi International are bringing peace and reconciliation to regions scarred by violence and war.
